**WHITESPACE ALLIANCE WILL ATTEND SUPERWIFI SUMMIT
THIS FEBRUARY 1ST THRU 3RD IN MIAMI**

Denver, Colorado, USA December 20, 2011: The newly launched international trade association called the WhiteSpace Alliance™, (www.WhiteSpaceAlliance.org) whose goal is to enable delivery of cost-effective broadband via standardized and technology agnostic solutions for WhiteSpace spectrum, has announced that it will be attending the TMC sponsored SuperWiFi Summit in Miami during the 1st week in February 2012 that is co-located with the IT-Expo at the Miami Convention Center.

This 3rd SuperWiFi event is sponsored by a number of companies, including Google, and other active proponents of unlicensed TV spectrum use. This availability is thanks to the world-wide digital TV conversion process underway to free up this valuable “beach-front” spectrum. (Often referred to in the US as “TV Whitespaces”)

“As the WhiteSpace Alliance is comprised of a diverse membership who share the common goal to collectively pursue the large International opportunity that the use of TV Whitespace spectrum represents, participating in the Summit is a natural next step..” , said Dr Apurva Mody, Chair of the WhiteSpace Alliance.

The WSA will focus on providing the emerging Whitespace marketplace with technical Standards & best practices that will assure interoperability as well as compliance and conformance between the various radio platforms that will come to be used in TV whitespace band spectrum.

The SuperWiFi Summit will be attended by a number of early hardware makers & a number of the 10 database providers authorized by the FCC, as well as others from the fast developing TV Whitespace ecosystem & marketplace.

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
